This is a special event, being brought to us by the Curator of Education from the Orlando Museum of Art, Jan Clanton.

Nov. 3: **American Visions: Edward Hopper, 1882-1967**
Painting did not come easily to Edward Hopper. Each canvas represented a long, painful gestation spent in solitary thought. There are no sweeping brushstrokes, no sensuous compositions. But his artwork speaks volumes. He eliminated detail to get to the essence, and in the process, filled the voids with eerie silences and pregnant pauses. His world is strange but familiar, and at times extraordinary. He depicted the 'frontier' of the 20th century. It was different from Rockwell's, but completely apt in its own right.

Nov. 17: **American Vision: Andrew Wyeth, 1917-2009**
Andrew Wyeth was one of the most popular American artists of the 20th century and one of the most lambasted. He recorded the hardscrabble life of rural Pennsylvania and Maine. In his scenes, life was grueling but with a sentimental core. Unbeknownst to many of his admirers, his work looked realistic but had many modernist overtones. His famous painting, *Christina's World*, hangs in the bastion of modernism, the Museum of Modern Art, in New York City. Explore the works of Wyeth and see his struggle between abstraction and avant-gardism on one hand and conservatism and realism on the other.

Women in Art: O'Keeffe, Nevelson and Neel
Creativity knows no sex, but one would never guess it studying attitudes in art history, art exhibitions or art criticism of the past centuries. Women artists who cracked the glass ceiling in the art world were few and far between. Georgia O'Keeffe fought throughout her lifetime that label that her work was too pretty or feminine or that she only painted flowers. Louise Nevelson was a sculptor who worked for sixty years for recognition. Alice Neel painted portraits that reached deeply into the sitters' souls to depict an age just as succinctly as Rembrandt. But don't think they are pretty or comfortable to look at. She was the most powerfully original portrait painter of her time.
