Charles Hosmer Morse Museum of Art & Winter Park Scenic Boat Ride

The world's most comprehensive collection of works by Louis Comfort Tiffany is housed at the Charles Hosmer Morse Museum of American Art, according to the museum. The Museum's Tiffany collection includes items like jewelry, pottery, paintings, art glass, leaded-glass windows and lamps, and the chapel interior the artist designed for the 1893 World's Columbian Exposition in Chicago. These works in the brand new wing that opened in February, along with Special Exhibitions like "The Now and Then Room," "A Church Record-Photographs from Tiffany Studios Photographic Dept.," and "Selected Works of Tiffany from the Morse Collection." After a docent lead tour and free time at the museum, participants will take an adventurous scenic boat tour of Winter Park. Located on Lake Osceola, the boat tour offers an hour-long guided cruise through three of the seven lakes and two, narrow manmade canals on the tranquil Winter Park chain. On any given tour, participants may observe large cranes swooping waterside to snag a large fish, or a lazy alligator languishing on a nearby bank. Every tour guarantees plenty of swaying palms, towering citrus trees, lush ferns and a variety of flourishing sub-tropical flowers. Breathtaking views of opulent private homes and exquisite estates sprawling along the shores are also a key feature of the scenic cruise. Cost includes transportation to and from The Villages High School, admission to the museum, and the scenic boat tour. Pre-show, we will visit Downtown (Old) Winter Park, which boasts a variety of different restaurants/cuisines.

Crystal River State Park & Homosassa Springs Wildlife Park

The Crystal River State Park gives the first glimpse at the earliest settlements in Citrus county. For appx. 1,600 years, people of the Deptford culture appear to have occupied this state, one of the most imposing prehistoric ceremonial centers on Florida's west coast. Depart the Crystal River Preserve Visitor Center docks for a narrated boat trip out to the mouth of the river at the Gulf of Mexico. Enjoy the beautiful scenery and wildlife while

learning why and how the native people came to dwell along the Crystal River. After that, enjoy lunch at Charlie's Fish House in Crystal River. Then on to Homosassa Springs Wildlife State Park where visitors can see West Indian manatees every day of the year from the park's underwater observatory in the main spring. The park showcases native Florida wildlife, including manatees, black bears, bobcats, white-tailed deer, American alligators, American crocodiles, and river otters. Manatee programs are offered three times daily. At the Wildlife Encounter programs, snakes and other native animals are featured. Cost includes transportation to and from The Villages High School, admission to the State Park and Boat Tour, and admission to Homosassa Springs. Lunch at Charlie's Fish House is on your own.
